The Search is on for the 2024 Oktoberfest Ambassador

September 3, 2024 – KITCHENER, ON – <u>Kitchener-Waterloo Oktoberfest</u> is pleased to launch the search for the next <u>Oktoberfest Ambassador</u>. Applications go live September 3rd and the new Ambassador will be announced at the end of the 2024 Festival.

Like the past few years, this leadership program is open to all who wish to apply between the ages of 19 and 29 and reside in Waterloo Region (within 40KM), regardless of gender identity. There is no fee to apply.

"The Oktoberfest Ambassador Program is a one-of-a-kind opportunity within the Region focused on young professionals," shares Executive Director Tracy Van Kalsbeek. "The role is a unique blend of opportunities for self-growth, skill development and volunteerism, all while celebrating both Bavarian culture and our local, diverse community."

Leading up to the Festival, which runs September 27 to October 19, candidates will learn about the roles and responsibilities of the Oktoberfest Ambassador, take part in festival traditions like collecting donations along the parade route for the Onkel Hans Food Drive, attend and volunteer at events as well as participate in an interview process. A selection committee comprised of community members has been put in place to select the next Ambassador (or Ambassadors, if there are several excellent candidates) and the announcement will be made at the end of the 2024 Festival.

Once selected, the new Ambassador will have the chance to immerse themselves in the year-round activities hosted by Oktoberfest. They will spend a full year learning about the Festival, speaking at events, making presentations and meeting people from all over the community and beyond – which gives them lots of practice so they are prepared and ready to go, once the Festival returns in 2025.
