

Onkel Hans Food Drive – 2024 Numbers are Up!

October 16, 2024 – KITCHENER, ON – The numbers are in for the 2024 Onkel Hans Food Drive in support of the <u>Food Bank of Waterloo Region</u>. Nonperishable food and monetary donations were collected during the Oktoberfest Thanksgiving Day Parade this past Monday, October 14th and earlier during the festival at Stuff a Bus events including the Kitchener Rangers game on October 5th and at two local Zehrs locations on October 6th.

In total, the campaign collected 7,854 pounds of food and \$11,018 in cash/online donations this year, which equates to 28,161 meals. These numbers are back on par with contributions made through pre-pandemic campaigns. Last year saw the Onkel Hans Food Drive bring in 9,981 pounds of food and \$6,057 in cash, equalling 19,911 meals.
