**February 27, 2025 – KITCHENER, ON** – <u>Kitchener-Waterloo Oktoberfest</u> (KWO) is proud to announce that it has been named a **2025 Top 100 Festival and Event** by Festivals and Events Ontario (FEO). In addition to this recognition, K-W Oktoberfest also received the coveted **Innovation Award** for its expanded outreach and awareness efforts in Toronto and the GTA, coinciding with the project launch of the LederGOsen Line – a dedicated GO Transit service, in partnership with <u>Metrolinx</u> and <u>Explore Waterloo Region</u>, that brought festivalgoers from Toronto directly to the heart of the Festival.

The official announcements took place on Wednesday, February 26<sup>th</sup> during FEO's Awards Gala at the Crowne Plaza Hotel in Kitchener, as part of their 2025 "SYNERGY" Conference.

"We are deeply honoured to receive these two prestigious awards," shares Tracy Van Kalsbeek, Executive Director of K-W Oktoberfest. "Our Festival has been an important tourism contributor to Waterloo Region for almost 57 years. The success of our GTA outreach project and the LederGOsen Line pilot reflects our dedication to expanding the Region's reach across Ontario, in this case opening doors to make it easier for guests along the Toronto – K-W corridor to experience our unique cultural experiences."

Also recognized as a **2025 Top 100 Festival and Event** with FEO was K-W Oktoberfest Festhallen partner <u>Bingemans</u> Koolhaus.

Kitchener-Waterloo Oktoberfest continues to attract tens of thousands of visitors each year with its authentic Bavarian entertainment, cultural experiences and community-focused Oktoberfest Cares initiatives including the Willkommen Platz, KIDtoberfest and beloved Thanksgiving Day Parade.
